



PMARC CODE OF PRACTICE

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1. The handling and riding of horses is a dangerous activity which can result in serious injury, loss or death. Neither Peel Metropolitan Adult Riders Club Inc ("Club"), nor any member of the Club Committee, accepts any responsibility for any loss or damage suffered by any person. All persons on premises at which the Club is conducting an event, do so entirely at their own risk.
2. Only Club members and registered Guest riders are permitted to ride at club activities.
3. Children and visitors are welcome and should remain within the clubhouse precinct or in the designated spectator areas of the grounds. Parents/guardians are responsible for the supervision of their children.
4. Each rider is responsible for their own safety. This includes all saddlery and personal items. Guidelines outlining gear standards are available on the Club Website (<https://www.peeladultriders.com/>).
5. Members should report any safety concerns to the Club Committee.
6. Gates into riding areas and the entrance gate to the grounds must be kept shut.
7. If a horse exhibits dangerous behaviour they will be asked to leave the lesson. If the rider is able to settle the horse, they may re-join the lesson. If not, the rider will need to withdraw from the lesson.
8. For safety reasons, any horse being ridden outside of a scheduled lesson is to keep to a walk only. There is to be no schooling of horses outside of lessons.
9. Should you need to lunge your horse, this must be done in the round yard provided using the appropriate safety gear (helmet and footwear).
10. All riders/coaches will be asked to complete a Personal Information Card containing emergency contact and medical conditions. This will be located at the clubrooms.
11. All incidents and accidents are to be recorded on the day.
12. No dogs are permitted on the Peel grounds.
13. Stallions and rigs are not permitted to participate in Club activities.
14. Any horse known to kick must wear a red ribbon in its tail.
